

WAR EAGLE AND WELCOME TO AUBURN UNIVERSITY!

We are very excited that you have registered to participate in the August 12 Orientation Session for Successfully Orienting Students (SOS) and Camp War Eagle (CWE).



SCHEDULE: The orientation schedule is available at auburn.edu/sos/programinfo. You will get an e-mail from First Year Experience a few days before your session with reminders and updates. This email will include links for presentations during your session.

PARTICIPATION: You are required to participate from 8:30AM-9:45 AM. You may also have additional requirements from your academic college related to advising and registration on August 12. Watch your Auburn email and your Canvas modules for more information. Please note that Auburn University is in the Central Time Zone.

REQUEST FOR SPECIAL ASSISTANCE: If you need to request any special accommodations which you did not include when you registered, please let us know as soon as possible. We will be happy to assist you. This includes all access and communication needs. Please also inform the Office of Accessibility at (334) 844-2096 or accessibility@auburn.edu.

BREAKOUT SESSIONS: Over 30 sessions led by various campus departments were recorded from earlier orientation session to provide you more in-depth information about their resources and services. PARENTS AND FAMILY: We encourage family members to view a presentation specifically for them called UNIV 101 for Families which will discuss the transition many families experience. The recording can be found at: aub.ie/fyeuniv101. Family members are also encouraged to view breakout sessions that interest them. If you did not initially register family members, you can add them by sending their full name, relationship to you and their email address to fyedesk@auburn.edu. Please send this request from your Auburn email account.

CLASS REGISTRATION: Academic advising and orientation will operate independently, and you should not wait to begin the academic advising process.

Incoming Transfer Students – In order to register for classes, you must have completed the pre-orientation modules (fye.auburn.edu/orientationmodules), which includes the transfer plan of study.

Incoming Freshmen – In order to register for classes, you must have completed the CWE pre-orientation modules (including the Academic History Survey) which can be found at auburn.instructure.com/. Your course is called Camp War Eagle.

All Students – If you have not already completed your pre-orientation modules, we encourage you to do this as soon as possible since it will take time for your advisor to review your information. Watch your Auburn email account for communication from your academic advisor.

DECLARATION OF MAJOR: You are assigned to a particular school or college (Engineering, Business, etc.) based on what you stated on your application for admission. If you need to change your declared major, please email us at fyedesk@auburn.edu so we can officially change your major. **Please make all major change requests as soon as possible as this may delay your advising and class registration.**

TIGER CARD PHOTO UPLOAD: Tiger Card is the required Auburn University ID card. Utilize the self-upload photo option at aub.ie/photoupload to submit an acceptable photo as soon as possible. More information about picking up your Tiger Card will be available on their website: auburn.edu/tigercard.

MEDICAL DOCUMENTATION: Due to the effects of COVID-19, the Auburn University Medical Clinic has moved the deadline for submitting the medical documentation form via Clearwave VacTrak to September 3 at noon. Students must complete the mandatory TB testing at the AU Medical Clinic. Please see auburn.edu/medical for more information or contact the clinic at (334) 844-4416.

MANDATORY COVID TESTING: All students are required to be tested for SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19, within 14 days of arriving on campus this fall. This requirement is part of Auburn's comprehensive plan for a safe and healthy return to campus. Testing is facilitated by Testing for Alabama, a statewide initiative, and led by the University of Alabama at Birmingham. EBILL DEADLINE: If you were registered for classes by July 10, you were billed for tuition and university fees. This eBill is due on August 7. You must pay at least half of the bill in order to keep your schedule. The second half will be due September 4. **If you registered for classes after July 10,** your first eBill will be billed August 13 and will be due September 4. You must pay the full eBill by September 4. To pay your eBill, log into AU Access, select the My Finances tab, and then select the eBill logo.

PARKING REGISTRATION: You will be assigned a specific date and window of time to purchase your parking permission. Registration windows began opening on July 21 for commuters and will open on July 28 for on campus students. You must have a class schedule prior to registering for parking. AU ALERT AND EMERGENCY CONTACTS: Before orientation, you should register your cell phone number in AU ALERT, Auburn's emergency notification system, and your emergency contacts using the form at auburn.edu/emergencycontacts.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATION AGREEMENT: Before any class registration activity may take place, you must complete the agreement. Log into AU Access and click the link under the “My Academics” tab. You will be required to complete this only one time in your Auburn career.

Students: Please begin checking your Auburn University email account regularly for important information. You will get an e-mail from First Year Experience a few days before your session with reminders and updates.
