SOS STUDENT PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

Check in, Involvement Browse & War Eagle Welcome:

Students begin the day with Check-in and breakfast in the Student Center. You will also have the opportunity to talk with a few of the many student organizations at Auburn. During the War Eagle Welcome, you will meet the Orientation Leaders as they share the overview of the day and some of the unique aspects of Auburn University.

Small Group Sessions:

Students will participate in two small group discussions that will feature a variety of issues ranging from university policies and resources to the Auburn student experience. The group discussions are led by an Orientation Leader and help ease the transition into Auburn.

Breakout Sessions:

SOS provides various information sessions from offices across campus. For example, there are sessions about Financial Aid, I Believe in Work from the Auburn University Career Center, How to be a Successful Student from Academic Support and a session about Getting Involved. You will have the opportunity to pick two sessions to attend.

Academic Advising:
